

Annex 6: Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

In order to continuously improve performance in the domain of Health, Safety & Environment, and to meet our Client and its customers Safety Policies, and to ensure the safety of all people entering Chemical Premises, it is required that each Logistics Service Provider provide a standard set of personal protective equipment (PPE) to their drivers.

In case the Logistics Service Provider is working with subcontractor(s), it is mandatory that the Logistics Service Provider instructs its subcontractor(s) accordingly.

Such a 'standard PPE set' must consist of:

- Protective cloths such as overall or long sleeved clothing and long trousers
- Helmet
- A fluorescent safety jacket
- Safety shoes
- Safety glasses
- Chemical protective gloves

Each driver presenting himself for loading/unloading must wear the PPE. When a driver does not have nor wear the standard PPE, he will be refused access to the premises.

REMARKS:

- In case the shipment concerns dangerous goods, the above list of standard personal protective equipment must be extended with equipment requirements laid down in Chapter 5.4.3 (Instructions in writing) and Chapter 8.1.5. (Miscellaneous equipment and equipment for personal protection) in the ADR-regulations.
- If additional equipment (e.g. face shield) is required, the instructions sent with the EDI / booking request to the Logistics Service Provider will be updated with these requirements.
